

Bishop McNamara Dress Code

Required for Boys:

- School khaki dress slacks and school dress shirt with school tie (tied at a reasonable length). Shirts must be completely tucked into pants and sleeves may not be rolled.
- Solid-colored maroon, white, brown, tan, black, gray or navy blue dress (non-athletic) socks without patterns.
- Brown or tan non-patterned boat-style shoes, laced and tied. No athletic shoes.
- Buckled belts (plain leather, black or brown with conservative buckles).

Required for Girls:

- School dress shirt, completely tucked into skirt or slacks. Shirt sleeves may not be rolled.
- School khaki slacks OR khaki skirt. (The hemline of a kneeling student's skirt should measure no more than three [3] inches above the ground)
- Students who opt to wear the skirt may wear either maroon, black or navy blue knee socks, white crew socks and/or maroon, black or navy blue opaque tights. No ankle socks are allowed and socks are not permitted to be rolled or folded to the ankle. Students who opt to wear pants may wear solid-colored maroon, white, brown, tan, black, gray or navy blue dress socks without patterns.
- Brown or tan non-patterned boat-style shoes, laced and tied. No athletic shoes.
- Buckled belts (plain leather, black or brown with conservative buckles) with the khaki pleated slacks.

Optional for all students:

- Bishop McNamara maroon cardigan, sweater-vest, or v-neck long-sleeve sweater, navy blue blazer with the Bishop McNamara patch on the front chest pocket (for 9th-11th graders) may be worn with the oxford shirt.
- No hoodies allowed.
- During winter months or on rainy days, students may wear weather appropriate outerwear, when traveling between buildings, but must remove these items when they arrive to class.
